She is also using a walker, under her physical therapist's supervision, learning to hold on and take steps forward. She is doing very well with the walker. It is very exciting to watch her take baby steps and to see her face light up as she makes her way across the room. Chloe is crawling around in what we call "turbo mode" and loves to try opening every kitchen cabinet (childproof locks are great)! We are continuing physical therapy three times per week, and Chloe Grace remains very motivated. She is cognitively healthy and is learning new words every day. These are real blessings! Chloe enjoys cooking with Mama, feeding her dolls, coloring, and singing "Itsy Bitsy Spider." She also enjoys watching Elmo and Barney, but she especially loves music and dancing. Some of her favorite foods are pasta, pizza, and bananas. Chloe really loves her bath time and any opportunity to be in a pool. She has fun spending time with her cousins and any children she meets. She entertains those around her and is always ready to blow kisses and give a hug. She brings us and our family and friends a lot of joy. We continue to thank God for every blessing and every person that has been a part of our journey. Thank you for your continued concern, prayers, and support.*
